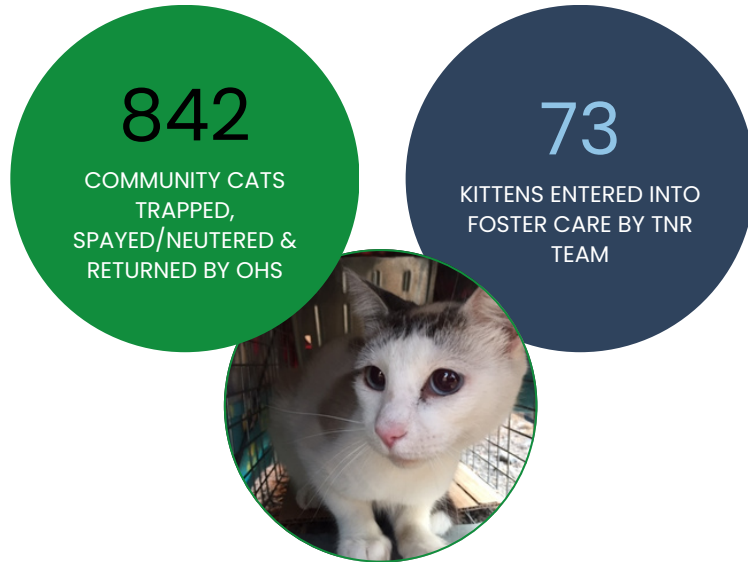

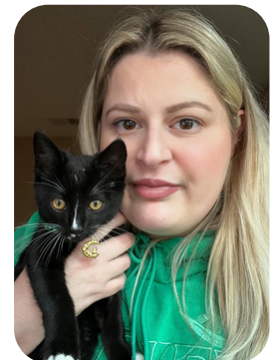

OHS OFFERS ASSISTANCE IN CONTROLLING THE COMMUNITY CAT POPULATION THROUGH TNR. WE EDUCATE THE COMMUNITY TO CARE FOR CATS WHERE THEY ARE FOUND WITH THE GOAL TO TRAP, SPAY/NEUTER AND RETURN THEM TO THEIR ORIGINAL LOCATION. WE ALSO INTAKE ABANDONED KITTENS INTO OUR FOSTER PROGRAM UNTIL READY TO BE ADOPTED INTO A HOME.

KITTEN FOSTER & ADOPTION

THE KITTEN FOSTER PROGRAM SPECIALIZES IN THE CARE, SOCIALIZATION, AND HEALTH OF KITTENS 8 WEEKS AND UNDER. FOSTER FAMILIES GIVE THE KITTENS ALL THE LOVE THEY NEED TO PREPARE THE KITTENS FOR ADOPTION TO FOREVER HOMES.

THE OHS WILDLIFE REHABILITATION CENTER RESCUES, REHABILITATES, AND RELEASES INJURED OR SICK WILDLIFE BACK TO THEIR NATIVE HABITAT. THE VOLUNTEER STAFF WORKS ENDLESS HOURS TAKING CARE OF THE ANIMALS, WORKING WITH LOCAL SCOUTS AND VOLUNTEERS ON CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS TO MAINTAIN THE FACILITY, GROWING PRODUCE IN THE GARDENS, AND EDUCATING THE PUBLIC ON HOW TO LIVE IN HARMONY WITH URBAN WILDLIFE.

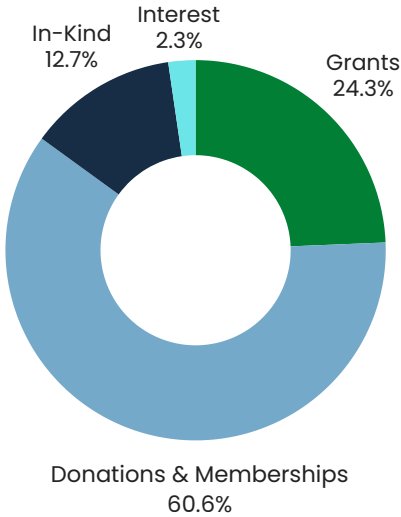

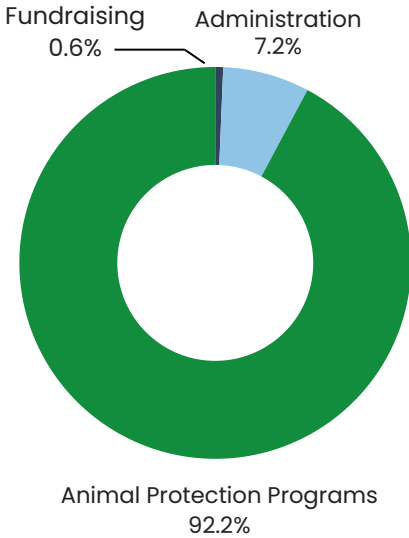
